First, *thank you* for booking with Get the Net Guide Service. I look forward to getting you on the water!

Here are some things to know ahead of our trip.

- Anyone 16 and older will need a valid California Fishing license. One day licenses are available. For all licensing information, go to <u>https://wildlife.ca.gov/</u> or just stop into a sporting goods store like Bass Pro Shop or Sportsman's Warehouse
- Bring whatever you want to eat or drink and a cooler with some ice (especially in summer) to take home any fish we catch.
- I have all the gear we will need- rods, reels, tackle, etc. If you have a favorite rod you want to bring, or lure, or whatever... no problem.
- I have life jackets in a variety of sizes, from small children to adult. But if you already have one for your child or yourself, feel free to bring it. *Children are required to wear life jackets*.
- Dress appropriately. Check the forecast. It can get very hot in summer, even first thing in the morning. It can get surprisingly cold in winter and spring, especially if it's a bit windy. My boat has a top for sun and rain protection, but we're still out in the elements for an extended period of time. It's better to bring more than you need than not enough. Also...sunscreen!
- Every scheduled trip requires a \$70 deposit to hold the date. It is fully refundable to within 24 hours of the trip, and it is applicable to your overall trip total. Venmo: @Thomas-Mailey. PayPal: @GTNetGuide. I can also do Apple Pay. The remaining balance is due day of the trip.
- Sometimes a trip needs to be postponed due to weather. If that happens, the deposit can either be refunded-if the trip must be canceled entirely; or simply applied to the re-schedule date.
- Client is responsible for getting to our meet-up site, and for any entry fees to those areas. I will communicate with you as to the cost depending on where we're fishing.
- I will do *everything* I know to get us on fish but please keep in mind, sometimes it's up to the fish. A trip-even with a guide- does not guarantee a cooler full of fish, or, on rare occasions, even a strike. The one thing I *can* guarantee is that I'll do my best to make sure you and your guests have a great time on the water.
- I welcome everyone! Please just let me know in advance if you or a companion has any special needs that require additional attention.
